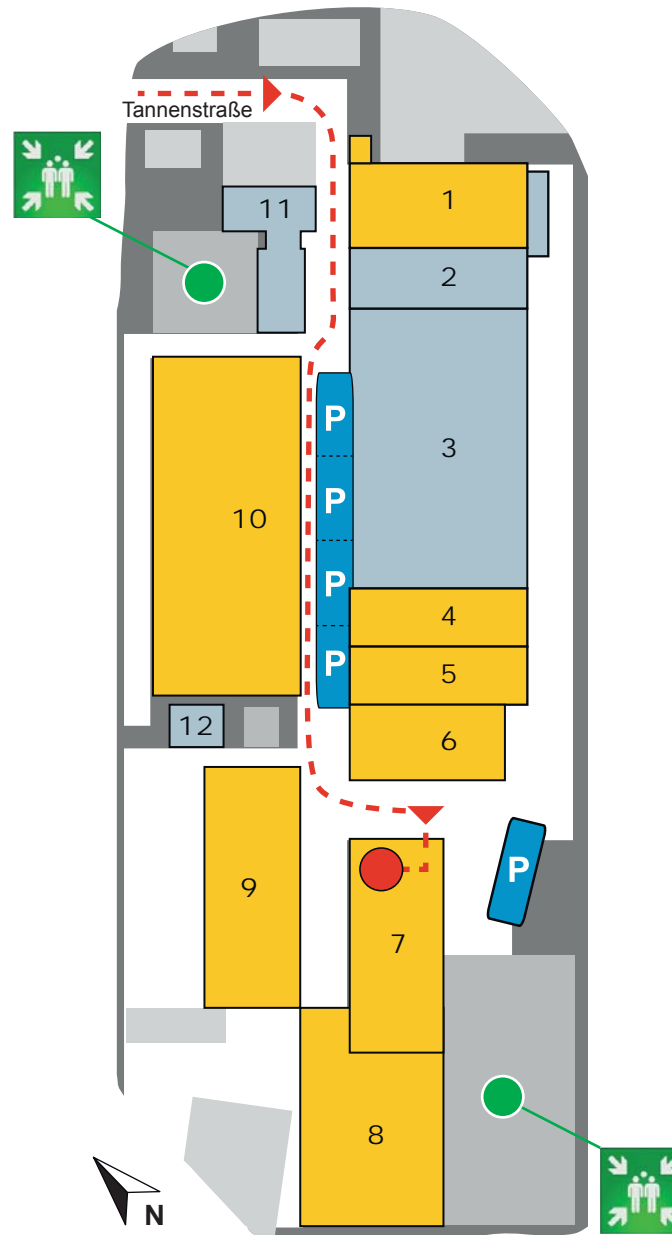

Safety instructions for carriers

On entering our works premises the following rules apply:



- You enter or drive onto our works premises at your own risk!
- Use the marked roads or paths – when and if they exist!
- Watch out especially for existing danger spots – including movement of fork-lift trucks and heavy loads being transported.
- Notify for contact person immediately on arrival and enter only those buildings or areas for which your pass is valid.
- Only enter production workshops when accompanied by a Vollmann employee!
- Obey the instructions given by the Vollmann employee! Permission to stay will lapse if the rules are flouted or contravened and one can expect to be denied access to the premises.
- Before your departure, please present your passes and all freight documents unsolicited to your contact person.



- Do not obstruct any escape and emergency routes!



- Notify your contact person about any accidents or emergency incidents during your stay.



- In the event of an evacuation alarm, proceed by a direct route to the nearest assembly point (see site plan).



- Road traffic regulations are to be obeyed.
- Exercise caution with regard to pedestrians, cyclists and works vehicles!
- The maximum speed on the works premises is 10 km/h.
- Turn your engine off when your vehicle is at a standstill.



- Fork-lift trucks have right of way!



- Smoking and alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited in the production workshops.



- Eating and drinking is not permitted in the production workshops.



- Vehicle drivers who are delivering or loading hazardous substances (leaches, acids etc.) must adhere to the relevant special measures and announce their arrival.



- Private passengers and animals brought along must not leave the cab of the HGV whilst on the works premises.



- Photographing, recording videos or making other documentation is prohibited throughout the entire works premises. Exceptions are possible upon request.



- It is forbidden to remove parts of work stations, conveyor belts, containers etc. Exceptions are possible with the agreement of the employee looking after the visitor.



- Wear a high visibility vest during loading or off-loading work.



- On leaving your vehicle always wear your safety shoes in the entire production and storage area.



- Wear ear protection in the designated noise-hazard zones or production workshops.



- Wear protective goggles when close to grinding or cutting work and when handling hazardous substances.



- Watch out for sharp edges or burrs when grasping raw or machined parts. We recommend that you wear gloves.
